He earned his PhD in Animal Nutrition and Management from the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences in 2004 and became a Full Professor in 2019. He is a member of the Vietnamese Biogas Professional Association and contributes to academic training at Nong Lam University.

With over 100 publications on animal methane emissions and biodigester technology, his work focuses on sustainable livestock systems, renewable energy, and greenhouse gas reduction. He has advanced integrated livestock and black soldier fly systems, introduced low-cost plastic biodigesters—now adopted in more than 500,000 households—and contributed extensively to technology transfer in the Mekong region through the MEKARN program.
